# Packing List

## WHAT TO BRING:

- Bible
- Pen/Pencil
- Bedding (Sleeping bag/twin sheets, pillow, blanket, etc.)
- Water bottle
- Wristwatch
- Toiletries
- Towels (at least 2)
- Sunscreen/Bugspray
- Modest clothing for 6 days (see dresscode)
- Closed toed shoes (required for some activities)
- Swimsuit (see: dresscode)
- Spending money for concessions.

## WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- Immodest Clothing
- Alcohol
- Tobacco/Vapes
- Drugs
- Pornography
- Weapons
- Prank materials

# Policies and Rules

## Medicine Policy

If you are bringing prescription medicine to camp, follow these instructions:

- Put the medicine in a Ziploc bag with your (or your student's) name on it.
- Include a notecard or sheet of paper with any specific directions for the medicine.
- Turn your medicine in to the designated sponsor at camp check in.

We will have a designated sponsor that will be in charge of medicine throughout the week of camp. All students needing to take medicine will go to that sponsor to get their medicine as needed.

The only prescription meds students may keep with them are an emergency inhaler, epipen, or other similar emergency medicine.

DO NOT bring over the counter meds such as TUMS, TYLONOL, etc. These will be available among our first aid supplies, also to be dispensed by designated sponsors.

# Phone Policy

We have a phone checkout policy at camp. At Monday Check-In, students must check in their phone. Phones will be stored in a secure location throughout the day. Every evening, after service (from 9-10pm), students can go to the designated sponsor and check out their phones. They will have an hour to call home or take pictures before they must check their phone back in. If parents need to contact their student during "non-phone" hours, they need to use the contact numbers provided in this packet.

# Dress Code

## **GENERAL GUIDELINES:**

- Shoes must be worn at all times outside the cabin.
- Apparel may not display or promote tobacco, alcohol, controlled substances, or inappropriate language or pictures.
- Undergarments must always be covered by outer garments.
- Midriffs should always be covered.
- No spaghetti strap shirts or dresses.
- No tank tops.
- No short shorts. At a minimum shorts must extend to, or just beyond, the camper's fingertips.
- No tight fitting or revealing clothing. This includes leggings or similar attire, which cannot be worn as pants.
- Girls may wear dresses/skirts, but they must reach the top of the knee.

# Dress Code, Continued

## SWIMMING:

- Girls should wear modest, one-piece swim suits. Males should not wear tight fitting swim suits.
- While going to and from the swimming areas, all campers must wear shoes; males must wear a shirt and females must wear a covering over their swim suits.

## Additional Rules

- Be on time! Follow the provided schedule.
- Stealing, abuse, or pranks will not be tolerated in any form.
- No profanity or cruel language.
- No contraband items such as: weapons, drugs, cigarettes, vapes, alcohol, etc.
- No PDA (Public Displays of Affection).
- No girls in boys' dorms, and no boys in girls' dorms.
- Respect sponsors and other students.
- Students must stay in groups of at least 3 people FROM OUR CHURCH while going around the campgrounds.

**BY REGISTERING FOR CAMP, CAMPERS AND THEIR PARENTS AGREE THAT CAMPERS WILL ABIDE BY THE RULES GIVEN BY FBC HENNESSEY. FAILURE TO ABIDE BY THESE RULES MAY RESULT IN THE OFFENDING CAMPER BEING SENT HOME FROM CAMP.**

# FALLS CREEK YOUTH CAMP DRESS CODE

All apparel judgements will be left to the **discretion of the Falls Creek Sta (FCS)**. If FCS determines a camper or campers should change their clothing to fall in line with camp requirements, then said camper or campers are required to do so.

SHIRTS

**Shorts must be modest.** Modest can be generally defined as extending to just beyond the finger tips or a 5" to 7" inseam.

Sleeveless shirts must extend all the way to the shoulder seam.



**Dresses/Skirts** must reach the top of the knee.



Shoes must be worn **at all times outside** of your cabin.



T-shirts and cover-ups must be worn to and from swimming venues.

SWIMWEAR

Campers **may not be barefoot** on the way to and from venues.

Tights may be worn under a garment that meets the dress code. No tight fitting or revealing clothing. This includes leggings or similar attire, which cannot be worn as pants.



No tank tops or shirts cut down the sides.



**Undergarments must always be covered** by outer garments (i.e. no boxer shorts hanging out or bra straps showing).



No Midri s/racer backs. No sport bras as tops (includes the 5k).



No spaghetti strap tank tops/dresses.

## WHAT NOT TO WEAR

Apparel may not display tobacco, alcohol, controlled substances, or inappropriate language or pictures.

# CABIN RULES

1. DRINK WATER!
2. You must always wear your wristband. If you break or lose a wristband, talk to your sponsor.
3. You must be in a group of 3 people FROM OUR CHURCH while roaming around campgrounds.
4. You cannot leave part of your group to go somewhere else at camp if that results in either group breaking the rule of three. Take a vote on what your group wants to do next, majority wins.
5. If you want to go running in the morning, you must have a group of three. Recruit two friends to go running with you.
6. You must always wear shoes outside the cabin.
7. Appropriate clothing must be worn at all times even going back and forth to swim.
8. Be courteous to staV.
9. Do not mess with sound equipment or the sound booth.
10. Pay attention to the schedule and where you need to be when it's time to be there!
11. Keep track of your student book, you will need it for Quiet Times and Morning Worship.
12. DRINK WATER!
13. Boys stay away from the girls' dorm. Girls stay away from the guys' dorm. This includes on the balcony.
14. Do not throw, drop, or spit anything oV the balcony. 15. The stairs are NOT hang-out space. Go up or down. 16. The DORMS are NOT hang-out space. They are for sleeping, changing, and bathrooms.
17. No food or drinks upstairs. Only water in closable bottles.
18. Keep your bunk area clean and picked up.
19. Don't leave stuV in the bathroom. Any soap, gel, shampoo, etc. left in the bathroom is free game for anyone to use.
20. DRINK WATER!
21. Turn your phone oV before turning it back in. No, we will not charge phones for you.
22. Do NOT share bathroom stalls (self-explanatory).
23. Do NOT get on anyone else's bed.
24. Please report cabin issues (toilet not working, light fixture out, etc) to a sponsor as soon as possible.
